## AMERICAN SOCIETY OF CIVIL ENGINEERS NORTH JERSEY BRANCH STUDENT CHAPTER SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarships are available to members of ASCE Student Chapters from Stevens Institute of Technology, New Jersey Institute of Technology, and Fairleigh Dickinson University. The Executive Board of the North Jersey Branch, American Society of Civil Engineers established these awards in 1985, with the first awards being presented for the academic year 1985-86.

1. Eligibility:

- a. Any full-time undergraduate student that is either in their 3<sup>rd</sup> year of a 4-year program, or 4<sup>th</sup> year of a 5-year program may apply for this scholarship without restrictions as to academic class or marital status, but subject to the requirement that the applicant must be a member in good standing of the educational institution and Student Chapter or Student Club at the time of application submittal and award. The Student's ASCE Faculty Advisor must endorse the application.
- b. The student must be a member of an ASCE Student Chapter or Club.
- c. The scholarship will be awarded only to those students who will continue their formal undergraduate education in Civil Engineering.
- d. Previous recipients of this scholarship are not eligible for this award.

2. Application:

The original plus two copies of the application are to be submitted to the President, North Jersey Branch, American Society of Civil Engineers or his/her designated representative by the Student's ASCE Faculty Advisor. Each application must be completely filled out (type or print) and include at least the following items:

- a. Proof of Student Chapter/Club Membership;
- b. A statement by the applicant of the reasons believed to justify an award to him or her;
- c. The applicant's plans for continuing his/her formal education and a statement outlining how the applicant will finance his/her education if a scholarship is awarded;
- d. Transcript record of academic performance and standing;
- e. Statement of appraisal of the applicant in terms of potential for growth, character, leadership capacity and interests from the ASCE Faculty Advisor and one additional member of the faculty.

3. Selection:

- a. A maximum of two applicants will be selected each year to receive a scholarship.
- b. Selection will be made by the Awards Committee of the North Jersey Branch, American Society of Civil Engineers. No faculty member will be allowed to serve on this committee.
- c. Selection will be based on appraisal of the applicant's justification of award, education plan, academic performance and standing, potential for development, leadership capacity, financial need and participation in activities related to the Civil Engineering profession.

4. Awards:

- a. The successful applicant(s) will be notified of their selection by the President of the North Jersey Branch, American Society of Civil Engineers or his/her designated representative.
- b. The sum of each scholarship awarded for the academic year will be a maximum of **\$2,000.00**.
- c. The awards will be presented at the North Jersey Branch Awards Dinner meeting during the month of September.
- d. The scholarship amount will be deposited in the awardee's account in the business office of the institution designated by the applicant in his/her application. Withdrawals can be made only with the concurrence of the ASCE Faculty Advisor.
- e. The North Jersey Branch, American Society of Civil Engineers reserves the right not to award any scholarships during any academic year.
