Roland Lewis will present the Waterfront Edge Design Guidelines (WEDG) program. MWA is leading a process to create design guidelines for the water's edge for waterfront development within the New York metropolitan region. The WEDG program is a unique collaboration between government agencies, non-profit groups, consultants and other interested stakeholders, that will result in a comprehensive, user-friendly set of guidelines. As a tool to guide and enhance new projects on an elective basis, the guidelines will feature design concepts to promote access, resiliency, and ecology.

In a similar fashion to Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED), a ratings system that encourages stakeholders to build energy efficient buildings, the MWA has established a Waterfront Building Council (which includes ASCE/COPRI) and a rating system. MWA released version 1.0 of the design guidelines in late January 2015.
